Open Data Policy Statement

Making certain agency data freely available via a web portal will make agency operations more transparent, efficient, effective, and accountable. It will support the agency's mission to facilitate the creation of a shared vision and regional plan with our communities and support communities in making vital decisions that strengthen our region.

Open Data Legal Policy
