## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING March 10, 2022

### **Amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* by Revising the Sewer Service Area Boundary and Environmental Corridors in the Central Urban Service Area**

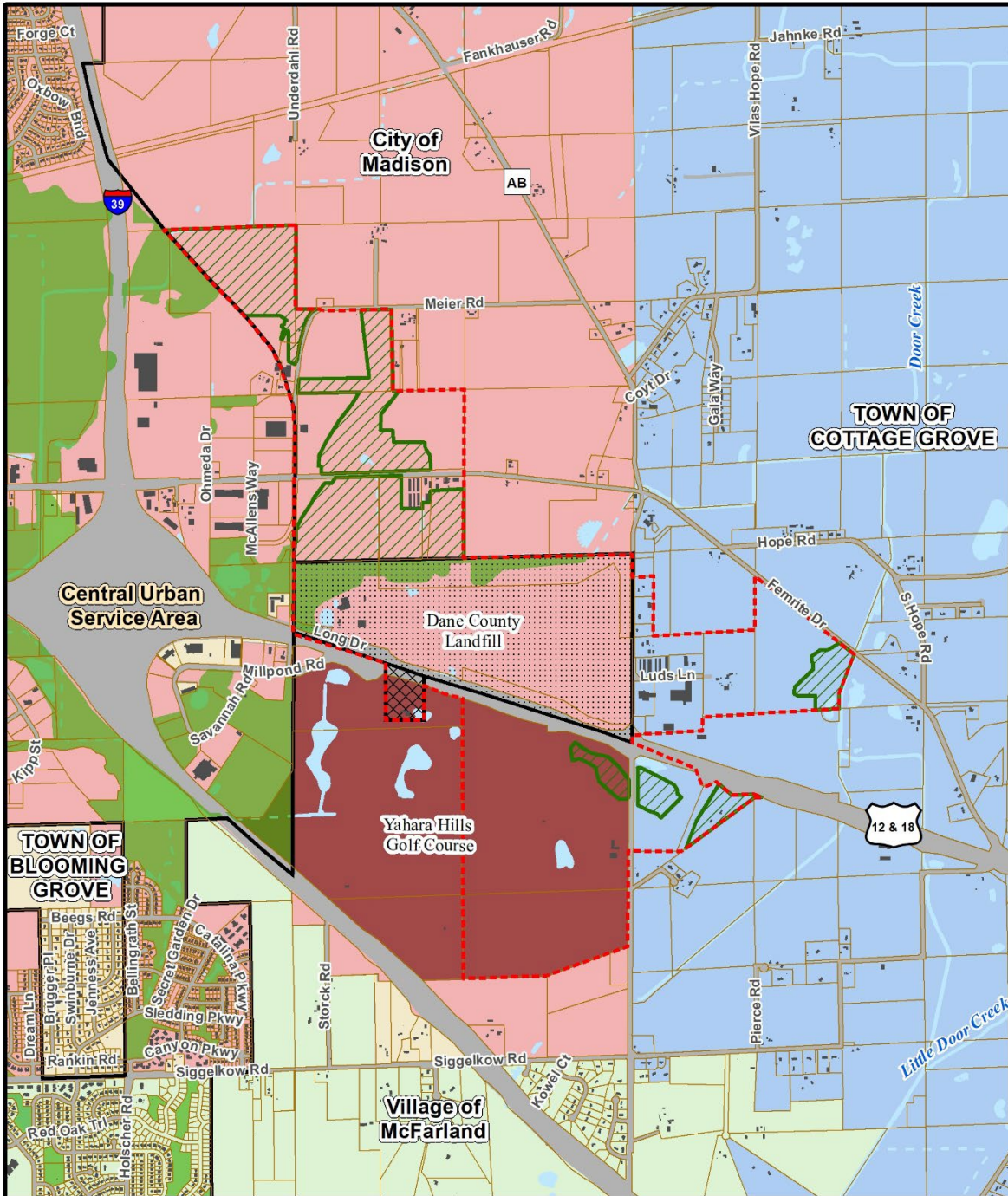
PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission will hold a public hearing convening at 7:00 p.m. on March 10, 2022, for the purpose of public input on a proposed amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* revising the sewer service area boundary and environmental corridors in the Central Urban Service Area, requested by the City of Madison. The proposed amendment is currently in the City of Madison and the Town of Cottage Grove, in the Lake Monona-Yahara River (HUC 12: 070900020702) and Door Creek (HUC 12: 070900020901) watersheds. It includes the conversion of the Rodefald Limited Service Area (approximately 249 acres) and the Municipal Golf Course Limited Service Area (approximately 11 acres) to the Central Urban Service Area. It also includes the addition of approximately 676 acres of land, including approximately 129 acres of existing development and road right-of-way, and 203 acres of proposed environmental corridors for a net of approximately 344 new developable acres to the Central Urban Service Area.
