Amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* by Revising the Sewer Service Area Boundary in the Central Urban Service Area

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission will hold a public hearing convening at 7:00 pm on September 14, 2023, for the purpose of public input on a proposed amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* revising the sewer service area boundary in the Central Urban Service Area, requested by the City of Madison. The proposed amendment is currently in the City of Madison, in the Door Creek watershed (HUC 12: 070900020901). It includes the addition of approximately 2 acres of land to the Central Urban Service Area. 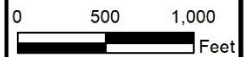


Map 1 Amendment Area
