



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**March 14, 2024**

**Amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*  
by Revising the Sewer Service Area Boundary  
and Environmental Corridors in the Northern Urban Service Area**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission will hold a public hearing convening at 6:00 PM, March 14, 2024, for the purpose of public input on a proposed amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* revising the sewer service area boundary and environmental corridors in the Northern Urban Service Area, requested by the Village of DeForest. The proposed amendment is currently in the Village of DeForest, with most of the area within the Cherokee Lake-Yahara River (HUC 12: 070900020504) watershed and a portion in the Token Creek (HUC 12: 070900020503) watershed. It includes the addition of approximately 175 acres of land, including approximately 21 acres of existing right-of-way and 17 acres of proposed environmental corridors, for a net of approximately 137 developable acres to the Northern Urban Service Area. 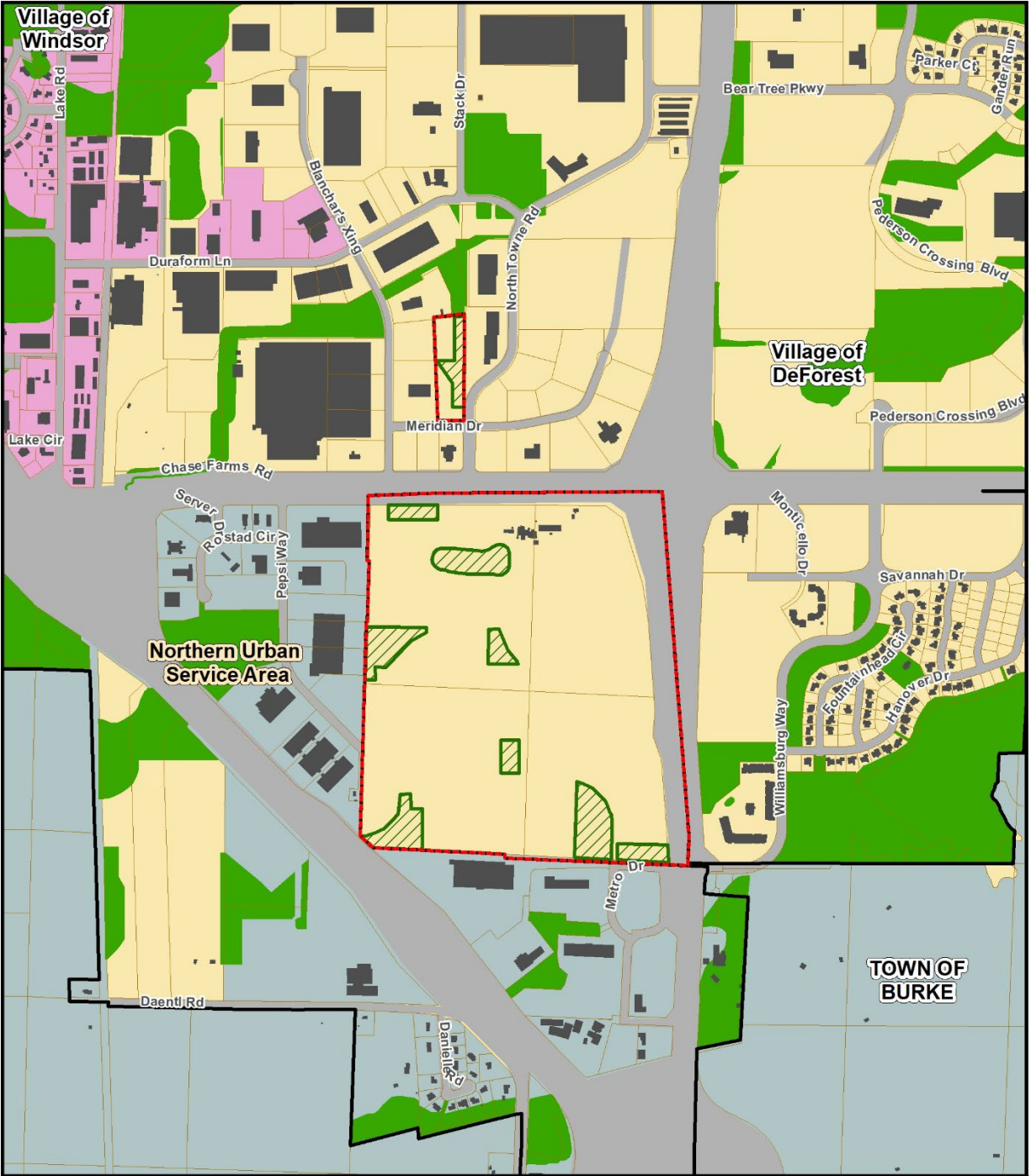

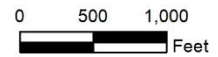


**Map 1 Amendment Area**
