Dear Mr. Bower:

On September 12, 2025, The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (department) received Water Quality Management Letter #2502 from the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission (CARPC), on behalf of the Village of Deforest. Letter #2502 requested the department's administrative review of a proposed increase in developable land to the Dane County Water Quality Plan. The purpose of the amendment is for the Pomp's Tire Service commercial site development.

Amendment Area

The SSA Plan Amendment includes the addition of approximately twenty-five (24.9) acres of land, including no acres of proposed environmental corridors, and six (6) acres of existing development and right-of-way, for a net of approximately nineteen (19) developable acres to the Northern Urban Service Area. The amendment area is located within a planned "Northern Interstate Corridor Area" which is incorporated in the Village of Deforest's updated Comprehensive Plan. Stormwater, sediment control, and other best management practices, as described in the amendment documentation shall be implemented, and the recommendations should be implemented to further protect water quality.

Administrative Decision

The proposed amendment is hereby approved in accordance with water quality standards requirements under ss. 281.15 and 283.83(1m), Wis. Stats., along with CARPC's recommended actions described in Water Quality Management Letter #2502. This amendment is a formal amendment to the state's Areawide Water Quality Management Plan, per ch. NR 121, Wis. Adm. Code. The Village of Deforest "Northern Interstate Corridor Area: Pomp's Tire" Amendment will be forwarded to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to meet the requirements of the Clean Water Act of 1987 (Public Law 92-500 as amended by Public Law 95-217) and outlined in the code of federal regulations, 40 CFR Part 35. This review is an integrated analysis action under s. NR 150.20(2)(a)3., Wis. Adm. Code. By means of this review, the department has complied with ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and with s. 1.11, Wis. Stats. The

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approval of this USA amendment does not constitute approval of any other required local, state, or federal permit for sewer construction or associated land development activities.

Appeal Rights:

Wisconsin statutes and administrative rules establish time periods within which requests to review department decisions must be filed. For judicial review of a decision pursuant to ss. 227.52 and 227.53, Wis. Stats., a party has 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the department, to file a petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the department. Such a petition for judicial review must name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent. To request a contested case hearing pursuant to s. 227.42, Wis. Stats., a party has 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the department, to serve a petition for hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. All requests for contested case hearings must be made in accordance with s. NR 2.05(5), Wis. Adm. Code, and served on the Secretary in accordance with s. NR 2.03, Wis. Adm. Code. The filing of a request for a contested case hearing does not extend the 30-day period for filing a petition for judicial review.
