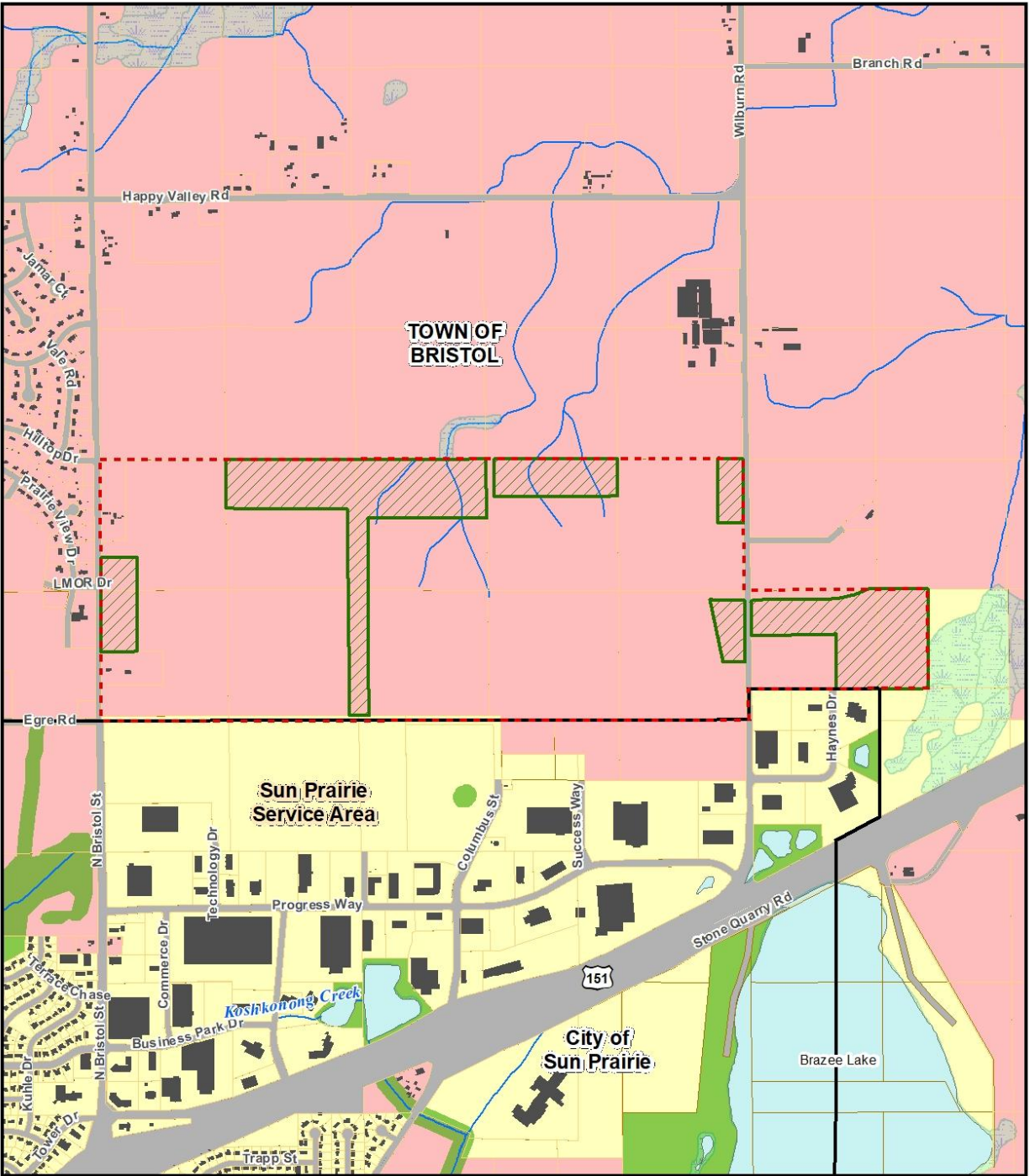
**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON  
July 9, 2026  
Amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*  
by Revising the Sewer Service Area Boundary  
and Environmental Corridors in the Sun Prairie Urban Service Area**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission will hold a public hearing convening at 6:00 PM, July 9, 2026, for the purpose of public input on a proposed amendment to the Dane County Water Quality Plan, revising the sewer service area boundary and environmental corridors in the Sun Prairie Urban Service Area, requested by the City of Sun Prairie. The proposed amendment is currently in the Town of Bristol, with annexation into the City of Sun Prairie expected prior to development, and within the Token Creek (HUC 12: 070900020503), Headwaters Maunsha River (HUC 12: 070900010801), and Upper Koshkonong Creek (HUC 12: ) watersheds. It includes the addition of approximately 440 acres of land, including 98 acres of proposed environmental corridors and 2 acres of existing development and right-of-way, for a net of approximately 340 developable acres to the Sun Prairie Urban Service Area. The application has or soon will be posted on the [Sewer Service Area Planning](#) webpage of the CARPC website.

This meeting will be conducted virtually via Zoom and may also have an in-person component (subject to change, refer to final agenda). 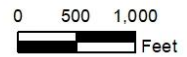
