NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON
October 8, 2026
Amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*
by Revising the Sewer Service Area Boundary
and Environmental Corridors in the Oakhill Correctional Institute
Limited Service Area

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission will hold a public hearing convening at 6:00 PM, October 8, 2026, for the purpose of public input on a proposed amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*, revising the sewer service area boundary and environmental corridors in the Oakhill Correctional Institute Limited Service Area, requested by the City of Fitchburg. The proposed amendment is currently in the City of Fitchburg and within the Lake Waubesa-Yahara River (HUC 12: 070900020703) and Oregon Branch (HUC 12: 070900020801) watersheds. It includes the addition of approximately 75 acres of land, including 1 acre of proposed environmental corridors and 5 acres of existing development and right-of-way, for a net of approximately 69 developable acres to the Oakhill Correctional Institute Limited Service Area. The application has or soon will be posted on the [Sewer Service Area Planning](#) webpage of the CARPC website.

This meeting will be conducted virtually via Zoom and may also have an in-person component (subject to change, refer to final agenda).
